Respect from the Victor

Joshua Chamberlain distinguished himself for his heroism in the Union Army during the Civil War. He was later awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor.



To recognize his contribution, General Ulysses S. Grant designated Chamberlain to receive the first flag of surrender as the Confederate Army surrendered at Appomattox.

The defeated troops expected to be ridiculed and humiliated. Instead, Chamberlain showed them kindness and respect. The Confederate commanding officer later wrote that Chamberlain was "one of the knightliest soldiers of the Federal Army."
